NOTES ON COMPLETION OF FORM AC

These notes should be read in conjunction with the relevant legislation.

General

This form must be completed correctly, in full and in accordance with the following notes. Every section of the form must be completed. Where the space provided on Form AC is considered inadequate, the information should be presented on a continuation sheet in the same format as the relevant section in the form. The use of a continuation sheet must be so indicated in the relevant section.

note one

As the application must be made by **each** society, the order in which the societies are named must be inverted or changed in each application.

note two

Section 51 of the Competition Act 2002 amended section 51 of the 1893 Act so that where a resolution is passed by three-fourths majority, the second meeting is not required. In such circumstances **Option 1** should be completed.

Where a simple majority passes the resolution at the meeting, the resolution should be confirmed at the second meeting and **Option 2** should be completed. The second meeting must be held not less than 14 clear days nor more than one month after the first meeting.

Section 1 of the Industrial and Provident Societies (Amendment) Act 1971 allows that where each society has amongst its objects and is engaged in the manufacture of butter, cream or any other dairy product the resolution can be passed by a majority. **Option 2** should be completed in such circumstances.

Please tick the appropriate box. Not every society has rules that allow for proxies.

note four

It should be clearly stated in the resolution which society's name and rules are to be used by the amalgamated society.

Form AC should be submitted in duplicate by each society and accompanied by Form AB - Declaration to accompany an application for registry of a special resolution.
