NOTES ON COMPLETION OF FORM LP1

These notes should be read in conjunction with the relevant legislation.

General This form must be completed correctly, in full and in accordance with the following notes. Every section of this form must be completed.
Where the space provided on Form LP1 is considered inadequate, the information should be presented on a continuation sheet in the same format as the relevant section in the form. The use of a continuation sheet must be so indicated in the relevant section and noted on the relevant continuation sheet.

note one This section must be completed by the person who is presenting Form LP1 and LP3 to the CRO. This may be either the applicant or a person on his/her behalf.

note two A separate statement (Form LP3) of the amounts contributed by the Limited Partner(s) must accompany this application, signed by the General Partners.

note three Where the general partner is a non-EEA/non Swiss national who intends to come to Ireland to establish a business that general partner will require the permission of the Minister for Justice and Equality to do so. Evidence of the permission of the Minister must be submitted along with the form. Such evidence can include a GNIB card (certificate of registration) or Green Card/Green book (front and back).

If the general or limited partner is an Irish company, the company number should be entered.

If, however, the general partner or limited partner is a company, but is not registered on the Irish register, the form should be accompanied by:

- (a) A certified copy (and where required authenticated copy) of the Charter, Statutes or memorandum and articles of the company, or other instrument constituting or defining the constitution of the company (in the original language);
 - (b) A copy of the certificate of incorporation of the company;
 - (c) A copy of any certificates of incorporation of any name changes of the company;
- Please see Information Leaflet number 6 for further information regarding certification.

If the documents above are not written in Irish or English language a certified translation is required.

If, however, the general partner is a company not on the Irish register, regard should also be made to Part 21 Companies Act 2014 and the requirements of foreign limited liability companies to register a branch.
